Manuscript Preparation Instructions

General Guidelines

- All papers must be submitted electronically in English to the Office of the Dean, Faculty of Management, Tribhuvan University (Email: fomgmt2080@gmail.com). The electronic version must be in MS Word (.doc) format.
- The title, author(s), affiliation, and current address of the paper should all be included. 2.
- The paper should contain an abstract (250 words), introduction, literature review, methodology (model, 3. materials, and procedures), results and findings, discussion, conclusion, and references.
- If a grant is received, acknowledgment and information about it should be provided. 4.
- Important equations/formulae, pictures, and tables should all have sequential numbers throughout the paper.
